Coursework includes two semester sequences in both beginning and intermediate Spanish. No previous experience is required for entrance into a Spanish class. Those with previous experience may be able to begin at any point in the sequence and earn credit for their prior knowledge, contingent upon taking the Spanish placement test in Schafer Hall 205A. Appointments to take the placement test (no charge) can be made by calling the Testing Center at 701-224-5658.

As a student, you will be able to take Spanish courses either on-campus or online.
